






# STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS






#### DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE




# **ACADEMIC PROGRESS**

As a result of our thorough oversight and monitoring, St. Aloysius has determined that this school is substantially compliant with the rules and regulations governing commaunity schools
